

NEW SOUTH WALES VETERAN GOLFERS ASSOCIATION POLICY GUIDELINE No.3

A guide to the requirements for acceptance as a participating Club.

- (1) Members must be aged 55 Years or older, and each Member must be a Member of a Golf NSW affiliated Club, and hold a current Golfink handicap.
- (2) The minimum membership suggestion is ten (10) members.
- (3) A formal written request for permission to form the Veterans Club should be made to the Board of Directors of the Home Club.
- (4) A Meeting of interested Members should be called to form the Club.
- (5) **Election of Office Bearers:** A properly constituted Meeting should then be called to elect the Office Bearers of the Club. (a) President (b) Vice-President (c) Secretary/Treasurer (d) Veterans Captain should be elected at this meeting.
- (6) A membership fee should be agreed upon, which would nominally be in the range of \$5 to \$10 per Year. This fee would then be revised annually at the Annual General Meeting.
- (7) The Secretary via the Group Secretary will be the main link with the NSWVGA.
- (8) The Secretary/Treasurer is required to send a list of names, Club Membership numbers, and Golfink numbers of all members to the NSWVGA Secretary together with a Cheque to cover the Affiliation fee of \$3 per Member.
- (9) The NSWVGA Executive will authorize Membership, and allocate the Club to a Group within the State.
- (10) The Group should then consider adopting a Standard Operating Procedures & Rules whereby the NSWVGA Constitution remains paramount at all times.
